[Translator's Note: In a series of folders in this microfilm, the title page of Folder VI is “Genealogical Information”. Lutheran Pastor Martin Friedrich Schrenk served the Glückstal/Odessa Parish 1880—1902 and the Grossliebental/Odessa Parish 1904-1908. Without any explanation, this document appears to be an attempt on the part of Anna, daughter of Pastor Schrenk, to list from memory individuals in the villages of Glückstal, Grossliebental, Hoffnungstal, Bergdorf, Neudorf, Kassel and Berlin where her father once served. Not sure whether or not these are names in order of their houses along a street in their village, so will not arrange them in alphabetical order, but leave them in the sequence as she listed them.]
